# The 2007 Dogwood 100

**When:** Sat. April 14<sup>th</sup>

**Where:** Winchester Swimplex, 111 Old Estill Sprigs Rd., Winchester, TN 37398

(There will be access to lockers and showers here)

**What:** Choice of 100 miles, 60 miles, 25 miles, or 15 miles

**How Much:** Pre-registration is \$30.00 and will end April 5<sup>th</sup>. After April 5<sup>th</sup>, including the day of the event, registration will be \$35.00.

Children 11 and under will ride free of charge. (if you want a meal for this child, it will be \$5.00.

## Please note:

All proceeds will go to the United Way of Franklin County.

The ride will be very well supported with food and help. Cell phones are suggested to help the support vehicle find you.

There will be Port-a-Potties at rest stops (that don't otherwise have facilities).

There will be the usual post ride feast at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. Café.

Large monetary prizes (enticement) will be given to the first rider to finish the 100 mile course under 5 hours (\$250) and the 60 mile course under 3 hours (\$100).

A fantastic new course that goes on remote back roads through to Lynchburg and back with the Century riders looping off through Coffee and Bedford counties. Though no climb to Sewanee the course is hilly and challenging (hence the monetary incentive). The course also is incredibly beautiful; it is a good alternative to the old Dogwood course which will be used again (every other year).
